



Students' Illness or Injury

Mild Concern

When a student has a minor illness or injury, the matter should be reported to the School Doctor, who will examine the case. Should there be a wound, injury, or fever involved, the student will be taken to the clinic for treatment. If appropriate, the parents will be called to arrange for the student to be taken home.

Serious Concern

When the injury or illness is of a more serious concern, the student will be taken to the clinic on the ground floor. The student will be in the company of an adult supervisor who will remain with the student until the medical clinic assumes charge. The supervisor will report the matter to the Head of Department/Principal.

In the case of a serious injury to the head, a fractured leg, or internal injury, the student will not be moved and parents will be contacted.

Illness and Medication

Any allergies or any other special medical conditions concerning any student must be stated on your child's "**Illness File**" at the clinic.

Any child brought to school with any illness symptoms will not be admitted into class. Similarly, any child showing these symptoms during the school day will be sent home. Parents will be notified in this event and must pick up their child from school.

Medication necessary for certain illness must be accompanied by a doctor's statement or a signed statement should be given directly to the School Doctor with instructions of its use.

Only the School Doctor will administer medicine.

The student will not be allowed back into class except after medical examination by the School doctor, or after presenting a medical report stating full recovery.

Emergency Procedures

In case of an emergency or illness the school will contact parents.
